

Our midweek Playgroup for under 5's has been running for around two and a half years! Here's an update from the Team...

Hi Everyone, we thought you might like a little bit of an insight into Tiny Tots (our baby and toddler group.) By 10am each Thursday morning our church hall is transformed into a child paradise: toys to play with, things to ride on, books to read,
