

A NOTE FROM THE VICAR

Dear Friends,

As we begin the season of Advent this Sunday, we are invited to look in two directions at once: *back* to Jesus' birth in Bethlehem, and *forward* to His promise that He will one day return and make all things new. Advent helps us slow down, pay attention, and hold on to hope in the middle of busy lives and a complicated world.

This year, we're delighted to share something new: our choir will premiere an Advent Carol written by our own Richard Lawn. Inspired by Jeremiah 23.5-6, it points to God's promise of a coming king from David's line—one who brings justice, peace, and salvation. Richard's new carol helps us hold together the heart of Advent: Jesus has already come as the righteous King, and He will one day come again to complete the work He began.
