Options include Hope Explored, Discipleship Explored, and our Bible Study Groups (this term looking at James alongside the Sunday sermon series).

NEWS, NOTICES & REMINDERS...

- St Peter's is seeking a new Church Treasurer. You do not need to be a professional accountant, but some confidence with numbers is important, and there will be a full handover and support. Please prayerfully consider whether you (or someone you know) could help, and contact the Vicar or Churchwardens as soon as possible.
 - We do not take up a collection during services, but a card reader is available at the back of church for Sunday donations. If you consider St Peter's your church family, we warmly encourage you to consider regular giving, which enables the church to plan wisely and support our ongoing mission and ministry. You can give regularly by Standing Order, via a paper form (available at the back of church), or through MyChurchSuite (MyGiving). Where possible, please also consider Gift Aid, which increases your gift at no extra cost to you.
 - If English is not your first language, the free Microsoft Translator app can provide live translation of the sermon and the spoken parts of the service. It is simple, uses little data, and works best if you sit near the front to hear the speaker clearly.
 - Alongside our 10.30am service, you may also like to join us for Early Communion at 9.00am. This is a quiet, prayerful celebration of the Lord's Supper according to the Book of Common Prayer, lasting around 30 minutes—a peaceful space to hear God's Word, reflect, and receive Communion before the morning begins. It also finishes in good time for those helping prepare for 10.30am. Do join us on Sunday 25th January or Sunday 8th February.

CHURCHSUITE

ChurchSuite, the church management system used in the Church Office, is available to all adult members of St Peter's. It is a helpful way to keep connected with church life: you can (with the usual privacy safeguards) look up contact details for others in the congregation, update your own information, and view the latest rotas, alongside other notices and resources. We encourage everyone to make use of ChurchSuite. It significantly reduces administration in the Church Office and helps us keep information accurate. We also welcome feedback on how it is working for you, so we can improve it.
