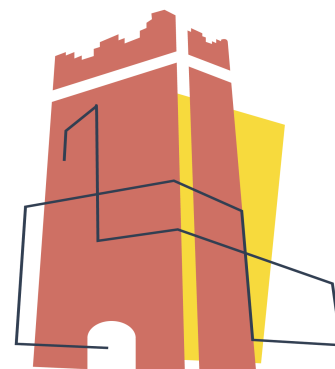

A NOTE FROM THE VICAR

Dear Friends,

I want to share a brief update on recent progress towards getting the work done on our church roof. After an initial drone survey last summer, the next step now is for a scaffold tower to be constructed in the churchyard, which will enable the relevant experts to access the roof safely and carry out a more detailed assessment. This is an important next step, as it will help us understand exactly what needs doing and plan the work properly.

As we do this, it is important to say that the roof work is intended to form part of a wider package of improvements, including better access and (we hope) making progress on the heating. Our aim is to take a joined-up approach, so that we address the bigger problem as effectively and responsibly as we can.

We are working on the basis that the overall cost for the work on the roof is likely to be in the region of £650,000. With that in mind, we are continuing the work of developing our case for support, so that we can make the strongest possible appeal to funders, trusts, and donors as we look to resource this major project.

Thank you, as always, for your prayers and support and encouragement as we take these next steps together.

- St Peter's is seeking a new Church Treasurer. You do not need to be a professional accountant, but some confidence with numbers is important, and there will be a full handover and support. Please prayerfully consider whether you (or someone you know) could help, and contact the Vicar or Churchwardens as soon as possible.
- Alongside our 10.30am service, you may also like to join us for Early Communion at 9.00am. This is a quiet, prayerful celebration of the Lord's Supper according to the Book of Common Prayer, lasting around 30 minutes—a peaceful space to hear God's Word, reflect, and receive Communion before the morning begins. It also finishes in good time for those helping prepare for 10.30am. Do join us on this Sunday (or on Sunday 8th February; please check the website for future dates).
