What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer by websites and sometimes by emails. They provide useful information to organisations, which helps to make your visits to their websites more effective and efficient.

We do not use any cookies which store personal or confidential information about you, only ones to ensure the essential functioning of the website

The types of cookies we use

We use two types of cookies on our website:

- Session cookies that are deleted after each visit
- Persistent cookies that remain in place across multiple visits to our websites

We do not use third party cookies for advertising purposes.

Session cookies and persistent cookies are necessary in order for you to use our website. These cookies can be deleted via your browser, but this will restrict the functions that you are able to carry out on our website.

Session cookies expire when you leave the website and are not stored on your computer and do not contain any personal data.

Persistent cookies last beyond your visit to our website.
